As part of our intake process, we will review your insurance coverage, explain your benefits and, if able to proceed, work with you to obtain the necessary authorizations for care.

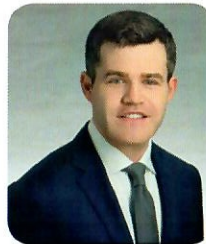
